### Call for Abstracts

**Deadline: October 16, 2020**

Swine Innovation Porc invites students and researchers involved in **Canadian-based swine related research projects** to submit abstracts for a poster session that will take place at “Le Porc Show 2020” virtual conference.

We are proud to partner with Le Porc Show once again to deliver the poster session, which will be in a unique virtual format this year. This event will give students and researchers an excellent opportunity to present research results to industry stakeholders attending one of the biggest pork events in Canada.

This year, we are pleased to offer the following cash prizes to the top three eligible\* posters, as judged by a Swine Innovation Porc selection committee.

**First prize: \$350**  
**Second Prize: \$250**  
**Third prize: \$150**

*\* Prize Eligibility: Please note that while abstracts from both students and researchers will be considered for the poster session, eligibility for the cash prizes will be limited to students enrolled in Canadian universities on a full-time basis.*

#### When and how will the poster session take place?

Posters will be available online for public viewing starting on November 25 on Le Porc Show’s virtual event platform. Contact details of the poster authors will be made available to conference delegates.

## How do I submit my abstract?

Abstracts may be submitted in French or English and should be focused on work carried out in all areas related to swine research. Le Porc Show is an industry event. Therefore, presenting your work for a general audience is strongly encouraged. Abstracts will be retained using several assessment criteria, including: overall quality, applicability of the work for end users, and accessibility for a general audience.

Abstracts should be submitted by email at [info@swineinnovationporc.ca](mailto:info@swineinnovationporc.ca). The deadline is **October 16, 2020**.

## What are the abstract guidelines?

- All submissions should contain comprehensive information and include the following:
  - Title
  - Authors and their affiliations
  - Background
  - Results and discussion (can be in separate sections)
  - Conclusions
  - Take home message
- Abstracts should not exceed 450 words.
- If your abstract is retained, you will be then invited to prepare a poster, as well as an audio presentation of your poster, due by: November 20, 2020.

## What is Le Porc Show?

Le Porc Show is an annual industry tradeshow that is based in Quebec City. Last year, over 1000 representatives from the pork sector attended the event. This year, the online event will include a virtual exposition area and will offer a number of lectures and breakout sessions that will take place over three half day sessions.
