The use of autogenous vaccines to control *Streptococcus suis* infections

Summary:

What are the best practices for using autogenous vaccines in pig farming? Experts from the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine of the University of Montreal and the CDPQ analyzed the effectiveness of autogenous vaccines with regard to the period of administration in piglets, and the potential interference with maternal antibodies transmitted by sows to their offspring. Researchers developed a conventional colostrum-free pig model to answer this question.
